#### **PURPOSE**

# **TERM**

The term of this position is one (1) calendar year.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Candidates for Past President must be members in good standing of IPAC Canada and IPAC EO and agree to fulfill the functions of the Past President as outlined.

#### **FUNCTION**

- 1. Fulfills the Terms of Reference of IPAC Eastern Ontario (IPAC EO) and IPAC Canada.
- 2. Coordinates, with assistance, the review, development and revision of chapter policies.
- 3. Reviews the chapter Terms of Reference and updates as required.
- 4. Assumes the position of Education Chair if there is no incumbent for that position for the current year.
- 5. The past president is encouraged to attend the annual IPAC Canada Conference, with financial support from the chapter as funds are available.
